Open Knowledge Finland ry annually awards the Best Open Knowledge Thesis of the previous year. We hope the award encourages students to conduct research in one of the many aspects of open knowledge, thus adding to the scientific knowledge of us all.

The topic of the Best Open Knowledge Thesis must be connected to the general theme of open knowledge. There are no limitations on the study programme or subject area for the thesis.

The prize for the Best Open Knowledge Thesis is a 500 € scholarship, a diploma, as well as speaking opportunities in OKFI's events.

Criteria

- The thesis has been accepted in a Finnish university or university of applied sciences.
- The thesis is a master's thesis or comparable, or any higher level.
- The thesis has been accepted during the previous calendar year with a minimum grade of "good".
- Open licensing is preferred in evaluation, and the thesis must be publicly available at the time of judging.
- The submissions must be sent by the end of April
